Timberparts Ltd. in Sussex, New Brunswick has received federal funding to expand its facilities and increase their productivity and efficiency.

in 1997, Timberparts Ltd. is an aftermarket remanufacturer that specializes in refitting and repowering fabricated products. Its customers are primarily in the forestry industry but the company is now attracting business from the mining, industrial and construction sectors.

The Timberparts project involves building a new 13,000 sq. ft. facility and the purchase of a 10-ton crane to assist with the company's continued growth.

ACOA's Business Development Program is providing a repayable contribution of \$500,000 toward the project, while the company is investing \$711,525.
